The Construction Industry Payment and Adjudication Act 2012 ("CIPAA 2012") came into force on 15 Apr 2014 with the objective of resolving cash flow problems in the Malaysian construction industry. Due to its speedy and cost-effective process, many contractors and consultants have opted to resolve their payment disputes by adjudication instead of litigation or arbitration.
