In this lecture, jointly organised by the Bar Council and the Gandhi Memorial Trust, Sharad Rao will speak on vetting of Judges and Magistrates in Kenya — a process unique to Kenya — and Kenya's Judiciary before and after independence. He will also speak on his experiences as a member of the Kenyan Bar for over 50 years.

About the Speaker

Sharad Rao is a Barrister-at-Law of Lincoln's Inn London and is currently the Chairman of The Judges and Magistrates Vetting Board, Kenya. He was a former Director of Public Prosecutions, and served on several occasions as Attorney General of Kenya.

He is actively involved in sports administration in Kenya and internationally, notably as Honorary Legal Advisor to the Commonwealth Games Federation, and a member of the Court of Arbitration for Sports ("CAS"). He also served as Judge on the CAS's *ad hoc* court at the Olympic Games in Athens in 2004, Beijing in 2008, and London in 2012. He serves on the Ethics and Conduct Committee of the International Cricket Council ("ICC"). He was one of three members on the tribunal, which dealt with spot-fixing allegations against three Pakistani Test Cricketers, and was on the Dispute Resolution Panel of the ICC World Cup in 2010 and 2015, as well as the FIFA World Cup in 2010.

Sharad Rao is a member of China's prestigious international arbitration body — China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission ("CIETAC"). He is a recipient of one of Kenya's top Presidential awards — Order of the Burning Spear — for distinguished and outstanding services to the nation.
