This seminar seeks to introduce participants to the law and practice of Islamic banking and finance as currently applied in Malaysia. Participants will be given an overview of the salient features of the Islamic Financial Services Act 2013 ("IFSA 2013"), and be exposed to the drafting of Islamic finance documentation based on relevant Syariah principles. The seminar will also cover the adjudication of Islamic financial issues through the litigation process.

About the Speakers

Jal Othman

Jal Othman heads the Islamic finance practice in Messrs Shook Lin & Bok, and holds positions in the International Centre for Education in Islamic Finance ("INCEIF"). He has also been commissioned by the Malaysian Securities Commission and Rating Agency Malaysia Berhad in relation to product development and regulatory requirements. He is involved in the Malaysian Central Bank Committee for Islamic finance law reform, and is also an arbitrator for Islamic finance with the Kuala Lumpur Regional Centre for Arbitration ("KLRCA"). Jal is a chapter reviewer and contributor to the International Shari'ah Research Academy ("ISRA").

Megat Hizaini Hassan

Megat Hizaini Hassan is a partner at Messrs Lee Hishammuddin Allen & Gledhill, and a member of the Bar Council Islamic Finance Committee. He graduated with Master of Laws degrees from Harvard University and University of Cambridge, and a Bachelor of Laws (First Class Honours) degree from the International Islamic University Malaysia ("IIUM"). He is a co-author of *The Law and Practice of Islamic Banking and Finance* (First Edition (2003), Second Edition (2010), and Third Edition (2015)); and *An Introduction to Islamic and Conventional Corporate Finance* (2012). He has written articles on Islamic banking and finance for several publications.

Hizri Hasshan

Hizri Hasshan is a Fellow at the Faculty of Law, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia ("UKM"), and a partner at Messrs Akram Hizri & Azad. He obtained his LL.B and LL.M degrees from UKM. He also holds an executive diploma in Islamic banking from IIUM. Hizri has been admitted as a Senior Associate Member of the Chartered Institute of Islamic Finance Professionals ("CIIF"). Some of his articles on Islamic finance litigation have been published in law journals, and he is now pursuing a PhD degree whereby he critically examines the legal framework of the *muamalat* court system in Malaysia.
