The Bar Council National Young Lawyers Committee ("NYLC") is organising a talk entitled "Law of Reinsurance". The law of reinsurance is in a language of its own, and can be an intimidating prospect for the unwary newcomer. Technical jargon such as "non-proportional facultative reinsurance", "quota share treaty reinsurance", "catastrophe excess of loss treaty", and "bordereaux" appear daunting and complex to the uninitiated. However, this talk proposes to discuss and hopefully elucidate some of the key terminology concerning reinsurance. Speaking the language of reinsurance will shed light on the key legal concepts and principles surrounding reinsurance as well, including the "notice-prejudice rule" and the "follow the settlements/fortunes clause". The relationship between reinsurance and arbitration will also be studied, especially in light of the recent Court of Appeal decision in *Ace Jerneh Insurance v Best Re (L) Ltd*.

About the Speaker

Michael Anthony began his legal career as a law teacher, lecturing in the subjects of the law of contract, tort, and trusts. He then joined the Securities Commission and was tasked with legal advisory work, and assisted in court and administrative actions for the Securities Commission. He joined Messrs Shook Lin & Bok in 2011.

Michael's area of practice is civil litigation. His work entails a keen emphasis on insurance and reinsurance advisory and litigation work, and he has acted for numerous domestic and international insurers and reinsurers. He has also been involved in a wide range of matters, including maritime and shipping work, corporate and commercial disputes, shareholder and director disputes, claims pertaining to defamation, contractual claims, industrial relations claims, and land disputes.
