Professor Richard Whish has been Professor of Law at King's College London since January 1991. Prior to that, he taught at the University of Bristol. He is also a professor at the College of Europe (Bruges). He is a qualified solicitor and was a partner at Messrs Watson, Farley and Williams from 1989 to 1998. He acts as a consultant to a variety of companies and regulatory agencies, and was, from April 2003 to March 2009, a non-executive director of the Office of Fair Trading. He was a member of the Board of the Singaporean Energy Market Authority from 2005 to 2011. He has also authored, and contributed to, various books on competition law, and was co-consultant editor with Peter Freeman of *Butterworths Competition Law*.

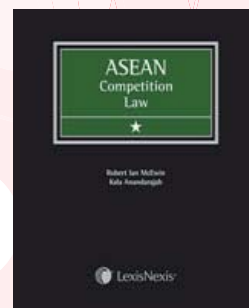
