Ravi Nekoo has authored several books, including two books on civil procedure that are widely used by undergraduates at local universities. He has also lectured on civil procedure to students preparing for the Certificate of Legal Practice examination.

Besides being in active litigation practice, he is a trainer who regularly assists the Bar Council with programmes such as the Advocacy Training Course organised by the Bar Council Professional Standards and Development Committee, and training sessions for the Yayasan Bantuan Guaman Kebangsaan (National Legal Aid Foundation).
