The Bar Council National Young Lawyers Committee is pleased to present the first of its "NYLC Top-Up Series", a series of talks, seminars and workshops for young lawyers, with the aim to improve the knowledge, skills and expertise of young lawyers in their professional practice.

Just a few years ago, a lawyer would be hapless without his or her diary. Important dates and tasks were handwritten. But these days, those diaries are a rarity. Lawyers rely on their tablets and smartphones instead to keep abreast of dates and tasks. Even losing the tablet or smartphone would not be a disaster as data are stored up in the "cloud" and accessible through other devices. This is just one example of how technology is changing the way in which we practise law.

We talk of going paperless, but how far can we rely on soft copies of our documents? What are the applications that we can download? Is the "cloud" really safe? The landscape of legal practice has changed significantly with the introduction of new technology. Lawyers already use mobile/smart phones, laptops, tablets, digital cameras and scanners. However, many are not using these gadgets to their full potential. This seminar will explain how technological convergence and synergy of gadgets can greatly assist lawyers in legal practice.

Foong Cheng Leong is the Chairperson of the Kuala Lumpur Bar Information Technology Committee. He runs a paperless and virtual office utilising numerous apps. He has also built an e-library of over 9,000 files and more than 100 topics.
