Martin will provide an account of the on-going efforts to secure justice for the nearly 200 men who remain imprisoned in the US Detainment Facility in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Since 2004, Foley Hoag has represented a Sudanese-born Guantanamo detainee before military and civilian courts. Very recently, the case concluded with the first successful plea bargain of the Obama Administration. Martin will discuss his experiences, including how US detainee policy has evolved since 2002 and especially since President Obama came to power.
