This forum aims to educate members of the public on the application of section 28A of the Criminal Procedure Code (Act 593) on the rights of a person arrested by the police. Increased awareness will promote better public cooperation during police investigations.

Representatives from *Polis DiRaja Malaysia*, Prime Minister's Department and the Malaysian Bar have been invited as panellists at this forum.

What is section 28A of the Criminal Procedure Code?

Under this section, an arrested person has the following rights:

- ◆ to be informed as soon as may be of the grounds for the arrest;
- ◆ to communicate with a relative or friend regarding his or her whereabouts;
- ◆ to contact a legal practitioner of his or her choice; and
- ◆ to consult and meet with his or her lawyer before the police commences any form of questioning or recording of any statement.
