Grover, a practising lawyer at the Bombay High Court and the Supreme Court of India, took up his functions as the UN Special Rapporteur on 1 August 2008. Grover is also the Project Director of the HIV/AIDS Unit at the Lawyers Collective, an organisation created by a network of lawyers that offers legal services to those living with HIV/AIDS. He has personally handled several hundred HIV/AIDS-related litigations in India.
