In the case of the former, the Bar only recently implemented the Continuing Professional Development ("CPD") programme aimed at enhancing legal knowledge among its members. SUMMARY OF CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ("CPD") MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS:

10 Mar 2012 67th Annual **General Meeting** ("AGM")

Resolution adopted to implement a mandatory CPD Scheme on a voluntary basis for the first two years.



15 Mar 2014 69th AGM

Resolution regarding a proposed series of dates for the implementation of the mandatory CPD Scheme was rejected. The CPD Scheme continued on a voluntary basis.

19 Mar 2016 70th AGM

 Resolution adopted making the CPD Scheme mandatory for Members, to take effect on a staggered basis. With effect from 1 July 2016, Members admitted as advocates and solicitors of the High Court of Malaya from 1 July 2011 onwards, are required to obtain 16 CPD points for each CPD cycle, and pupils who commenced their pupillage from 1 July 2016 onwards, are required to obtain 8 CPD points in the course of their pupillage.

17 Mar 2018 72nd AGM

Resolution adopted to extend the CPD Scheme to Members admitted as advocates and solicitors of the High Court of Malaya from 1 July 2006 to 30 June 2011. With effect from 1 July 2018, these Members are required to obtain 16 CPD points in each CPD cycle.




