## Overview

This session is a practitioner's introduction to the practicalities of obtaining a grant of representation from the High Court.

From the questions to ask when a client walks into the office to compiling the list of assets, preparing the originating summons and affidavit in support, attending the hearing and things to do post-hearing, we will explore these together with the relevant procedures, customs and practices of the registrars.
