## ABOUT THE YLL PROGRAMME

**We are calling on young lawyers with seven years of practice or fewer to step up and serve as Young Lawyers Liaisons ("YLLs")** — dedicated points of contact stationed within each Bar Council committee. YLLs play a vital role in bridging the gap between Bar Council committees and the broader young lawyers community, ensuring that your perspectives, concerns and ideas are heard, considered, and acted upon.

## WHAT WILL YOU DO AS A YLL?

<b>Amplify Young Voices</b> Relay concerns and ideas from young lawyers back to your committee	<b>Drive Outreach</b> Ensure committee communications reach young lawyers effectively
<b>Champion Initiatives</b> Introduce programmes aligned with committees' themes and aims	<b>Build Community</b> Foster engagement and participation among young Members of the Bar

## WHO CAN APPLY?

**YLLs with seven years of practice or fewer:** Any member of the Malaysian Bar with seven years of practice or fewer who is passionate about a particular committee's work and wants to make a meaningful contribution is warmly encouraged to apply. Each committee may host **one to two YLLs**, depending on its size and scope.

## YLL BRIEFING SESSION

### Orientation and Guidance Briefing

All appointed YLLs will be invited to an orientation briefing organised by NYLPC. The briefing will provide general guidance on a YLL's role, expectations and how to work effectively within their respective committee's framework and objectives. Details will be shared with appointed YLLs in due course.
