On 25 Oct 2013, the Malaysian Government announced that the Goods and Services Tax ("GST") will be implemented on 1 Apr 2015. GST is set to replace the current sales and services tax. In light of the development, the Perak Bar Committee, in collaboration with the Bar Council Continuing Professional Development ("CPD") Department, is organising a seminar to provide Members of the Bar with information regarding the GST.

The seminar will cover the following areas: (1) Key GST principles; (2) Scope and charges to tax; (3) Case studies (in relation to GST); (4) Comparative legislation; (5) Criminal provisions; and (6) Implications on law firms.

Registration for the seminar will begin at 2:00 pm.
