

International Mediation Summit 2022

Xiamen, China | 24 and 25 Nov 2022

To advance international cooperation and communication in mediation and promote law-based governance, internationalisation and facilitation of a business-friendly environment, the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade (“CCPIT”) will hold an International Mediation Summit 2022 (“IMS 2022”) in November 2022 in Xiamen, Fujian province.

In the past years, six consecutive summits have taken place since 2016 which enjoyed great success and attracted participants including senior public officials, business and legal professionals. The International Mediation Summit has been considered one of the most influential international summits for mediation in China.

IMS 2022 will be co-hosted by CCPIT and Xiamen Municipal People’s Government. CCPIT Commercial Legal Service Center and CCPIT Xiamen are the organisers of the summit. CCPIT Mediation Center and CCPIT Xiamen Committee Department of Legal Affairs will undertake execution of the summit.

The theme of this year is “Challenge, Innovation, and Opportunity – Striving to Establish a New Development Paradigm of Multiple Resolution Mechanism of International Commercial Disputes”. The theme covers the following five topics:

- ◆ China’s New Achievements in Promoting the Construction of Multiple Dispute Resolution Mechanism;
- ◆ New Developments of Dispute Resolution on Trade and Investment among Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (“RCEP”) Member Countries;
- ◆ New Changes of Dispute Resolution Mechanism in European and American Countries;
- ◆ Strengthening Mediation & Arbitration on Intellectual Property Disputes, Enhancing Global Intellectual Property Protection Level; and
- ◆ Tradition and Innovation of Dispute Resolution System among BRICS countries (Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa).
